Application of Labelling and MEPS regulations to Air conditioners designed for installation in Caravans, Mobile Homes, Campervans and Rail Cars

Rulings:

Caravans, Mobile Homes, Camper Vans & Rail Cars:

The Scope of the standard (Clause 1.1) air conditioners powered by mains electricity specifically designed and sold only for installation in end-use mobile applications of caravans, mobile homes, camper vans & rail cars is not a regulatory focus at this time. However this may be subject to change and in the event that it does, industry stakeholders will be provided with a minimum of 12 months notice of any change.*

** Note: if and when they do become a regulatory focus, the scope of the standard will be changed to specifically include them. In addition, legal opinion/statement will be obtained or COAG agreement that the existing RIS includes such equipment.*
