

## Redevelopment of the [Energy Rating website](#)

Dear Registrants,

The Energy Rating website, in its current format, has been operating since 2002. Since that time web technology has changed significantly. With this in mind the Equipment Energy Efficiency Committee (All Australian and New Zealand Governments) has decided to redevelop the website to improve speed, useability and functionality. The aim is to streamline the registration process to;



- provide more intuitive entry forms including automated entry,
- provide improved edit-ability and easy URL and image uploads,
- improve access to information including more intuitive search functions,
- provide easier regulator comparisons,
- improve auto email facilities and
- provide RSS feeds to deliver up to date information, on the regulatory environment, specific to user needs.

WSP Digital have been appointed to undertake this work. The expected completion date is June 2011. The current registration process will remain in operation until full user testing has taken place on the new version.

The key aim of the redevelopment is to improve user efficiency therefore user testing is of the utmost importance. With this in mind you may be approached to provide input or test the design and build of the new website. If you are approached I would be grateful if you could respond to our developers in a timely manner to enable them to provide you with the best possible outcome. This will normally be facilitated through our project manager Karen Goldspink.
